

INFORMATION ON HOW FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID IS APPLIED TO BUSINESS OFFICE ACCOUNTS

Reed College's tuition is billed through the students' Business Office account. This account is also used to bill other educationally related charges such as health insurance, health center charges, printing charges, library fines, etc.

If you are receiving Federal Financial Aid/Title IV funding (*Direct Loans, Perkins, Pell, SEOG*) and you want the funds to pay educationally related charges other than tuition, fees, room and board, you must provide the college with authorization, either on this form or on your Financial Aid Award letter each academic year.

Students will not be fully registered until current term fees and any other amounts currently owed to the College are paid in full.

If you do not provide this authorization each academic year, you may be issued a refund check for excess aid that would leave a balance owing from health insurance, health center charges, printing charges, library fines, etc. If you do not want your registration placed on hold for this balance owing, please complete the authorization below that would allow Federal Financial Aid to pay these amounts.
