

Reed College Financial Aid Application Checklist Current Students: 2012-13

- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) **by April 1, 2012**. The FAFSA is an online application available at www.fafsa.gov.
- File the College Scholarship Service (CSS) PROFILE by **April 1, 2012**. The CSS PROFILE is an online application available at www.collegeboard.com.
- Submit copies of your and your parents' 2011 IRS income tax returns, W-2s, 1099 statements, and the verification worksheet with the **College Board IDOC service by April 15th, 2012**.
- Once your taxes are submitted to the IRS for 2011, **you and your parents** must use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to update your 2012-13 FAFSA. Please note if your parents are married but filing separately, or recently separated/divorced, they may be unable to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool and will need to submit an **IRS transcript** of their 2011 tax return directly to the financial aid office.
- Submit a 2012-13 **Authorization to Release Information form** (optional) to the financial aid office. If a student would like to release financial information to parent(s) or another party, please complete this optional form which can be found at <http://www.reed.edu.financialaid/>.
- If you wish to check the status of your financial aid application, log in to Banner Self-Service at <http://www.reed.edu/financialaid/banner.html>.

LATE APPLICATIONS HAVE CONSEQUENCES:

Applications complete by:

May 1 – (On Time) = Full Consideration
May 2 – July 1 = 10-40% Reduction in Reed Grant
After July 1 – NO INSTITUTIONAL AID, federal aid only
