
## **Hiacoomes Family Tree**



**Reading the Family Tree**: Individuals in squares have biographies in *Indian Converts*. Page numbers refer to the original 1727 edition and can be found in brackets at the top center of the current edition. IC I.4 means the fourth biography in the first chapter of Indian Converts. WG# (sometimes just #) is the number given to each individual in Segel and Pierce's *Wampanoag Genealogical History*, vol. 1.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Abigail Norton (b. 1666) was a white settler and the daughter of Isaac Norton and Ruth Bayes (Banks, *History of Martha's Vinyard* "Tribe of Isaac Norton," #31, p. ?). It is believed that she married Richard Weeks (c.1653-1724). On December 28, 1680, Samuell Coomes was fined for fornication with Abigail Nortonand "she was to be whipped or married to him (Segel & Pierce I. 142).

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> M. Thomas Coomes (#497) in 1749 and then (#1377) on 25 March, 1769. Perhaps daughter of Dorcus (#649) and Joseph (#124), and sister of Matthia #228. Probably mother of #509 & #1443-7.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Mother of bastard child presented to court in 1758.
