1. Page vii, Section 5.1: fix broken type.
2. Page 9: Warning: Problem 11(c) requires the quadratic formula.
3. Page 15, line 2: remove “it”.
4. Page 78, Eq. 3.14: remove second minus sign.
5. Page 109: Warning: Problem 6 requires logarithms.
6. Page 115: **Problem 10** should read **Problem 12**, and all problem numbers from here on should be advanced by 2, through **Problem 34**, on page 140.
7. Page 126: eliminate the paragraph break under “antiparticles,” beginning with “This raises ...”.
8. Page 131: remove the word “opposite” in the first line of the second paragraph.
9. Page 140: **Problem 36** should read **Problem 37**, and **Problem 37** should read **Problem 38**.
10. Page 140: old Problem 37 (now 38), line 2: change “light meson ( $\pi$  or  $K$ )” to read “pion”.
11. Page 162, Problem 12, line 3: “page 143” should read “page 144”.
12.
