

## France: Academic Programs Abroad (APA)

Reed students, in cooperation with campuses of the Université de Paris and coordinating associations, can take classes in a diverse array of disciplinary areas including French literature, history, and culture. Students will live with French families and participate in a variety of cultural and artistic events.

**Qualifications:** At least 2 years of college level French

**Term duration:** Semester or Year

**Typical course load:** Four or five classes  
Classes are typically 3 Credit Hours

**Courses recorded in:** Credit Hours

**Translates to Reed units:** 3 Credit Hours = .75 Reed unit

**Grading system:** 0 to 20
