Reed's oldest program was established in 1972 with the Universität München, founded in 1472 in Bavaria.

Qualifications: Sophomore standing and at least 2 years of college-level German or the equivalent at the beginning of the program in September as determined by German Literature Department. Students who complete first year German at Reed and will take summer intensive German in Germany or in the U.S. may apply.
