To be admitted to the ICPS program, a student must petition the ICPS Committee for acceptance into upper-division standing.

Any two ICPS-history courses, only one of which may be American History _____

Sociology 211 and one ICPS-sociology course _____

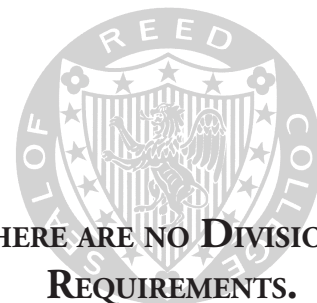
