













The Anthropological Study of Kinship

- clan (descent group)
 - matrilineal (cognates)
 - patrilineal (agnates)
- marriage: monogamy/polygamy
 - polygyny (one man marries mult. wives)
 - polyandry (one woman marries mult. husbands)
 - exogamy (marry outside group)
 - endogamy (marry inside group)
- affines (relation by marriage)
- consanguines (rel. by blood)
