


## **Radical Semiotics** (structuralism)


"Langue is a system of pure values determined by nothing but the momentary arrangement of its terms" (p. 80)

## Radical Pragmatics (structural functionalism)

"Sapir-Whorf hypothesis' is shorthand for a simplistic and easily dismissible 'strong' version of Sapir and Whorf's beliefs, which (mistakenly states that language determines thought" (Ahearn, p. 91) Sapir and Whorf's ideas as an axiom, NOT a "hypothesis": a Semio-Pragmatics?



Dynamic, mutually influencing relations in specific activities: "Purely linguistic facts may be seen as specialized forms of symbolic behavior" (Sapir p. 163)
