Close access to food supply and production

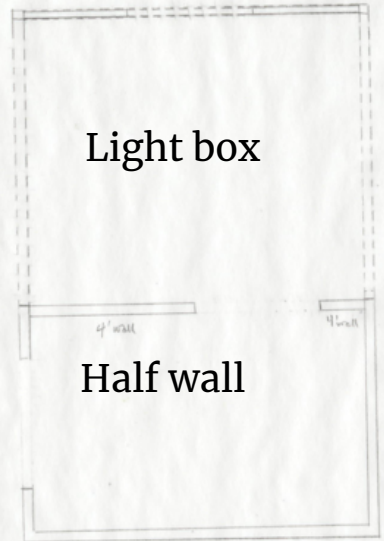
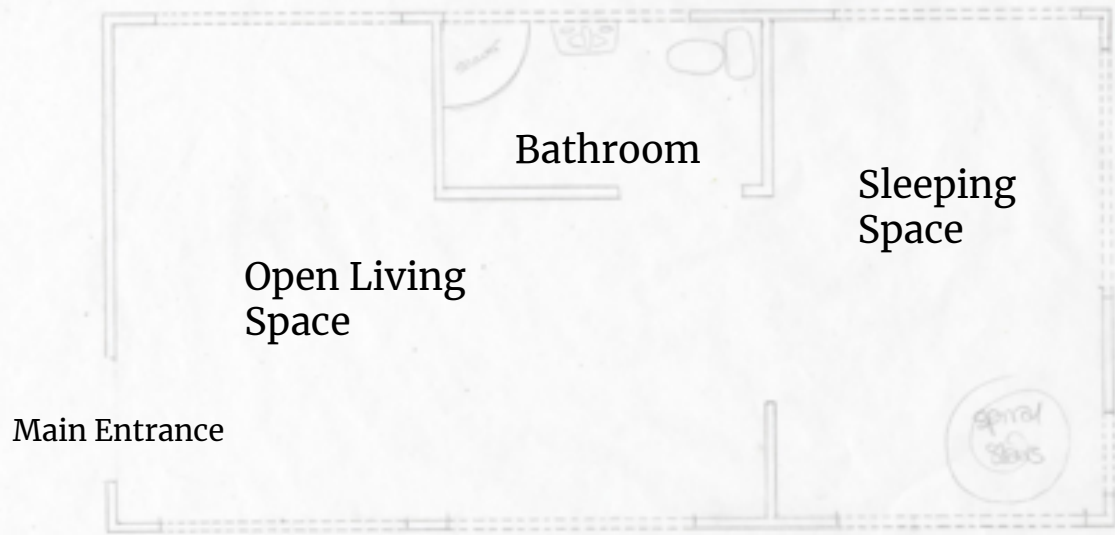
Long-term capacity for structures (can be set into ground)

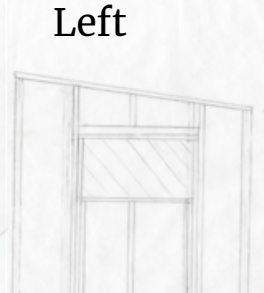
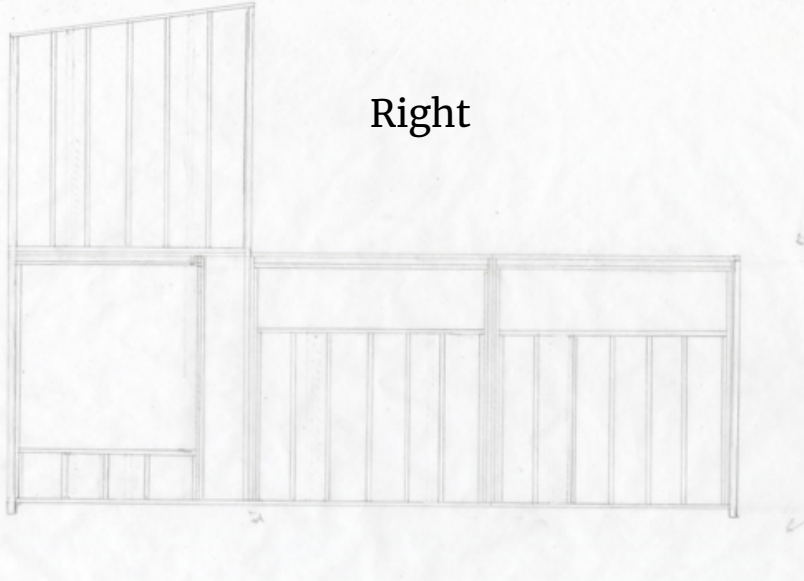

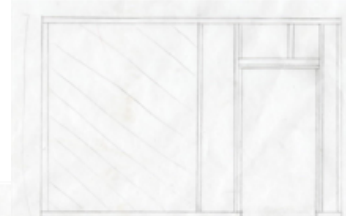

Floor Plan: Very Open



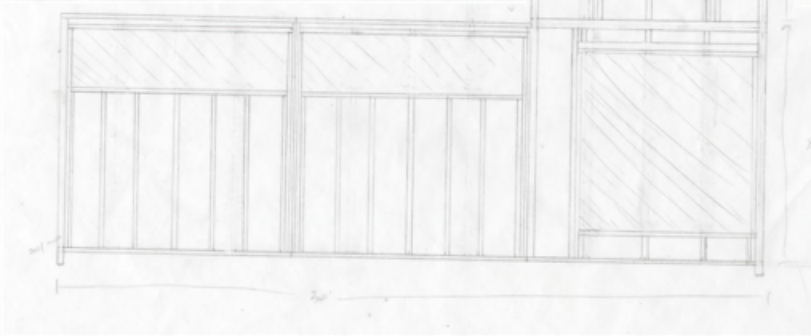
Front (2nd floor)



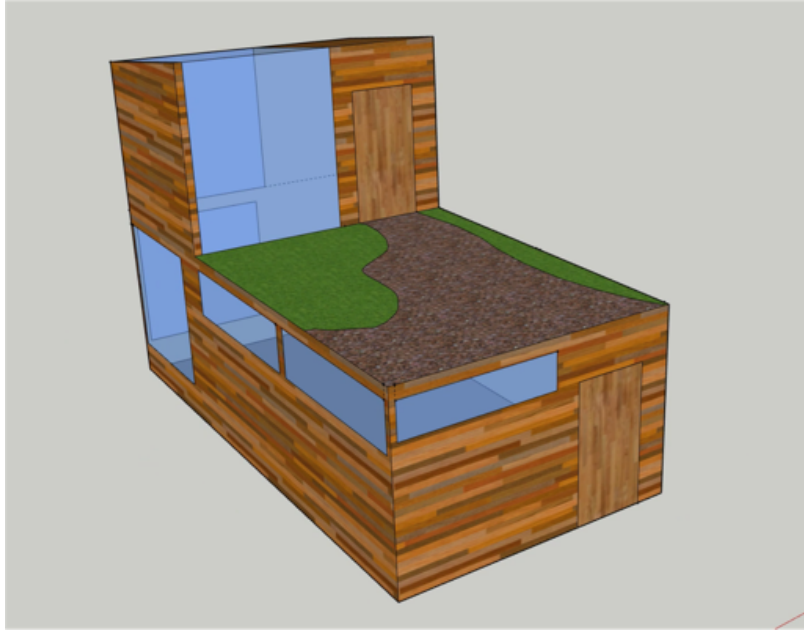
Front (1st floor)

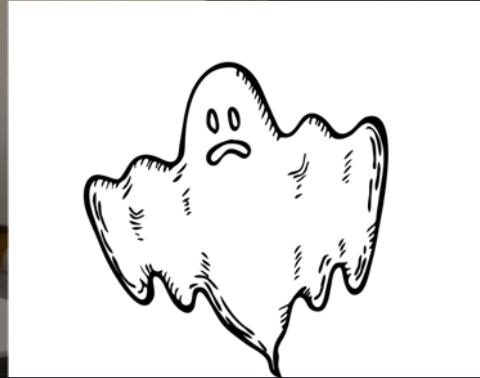

Night Time Lighting



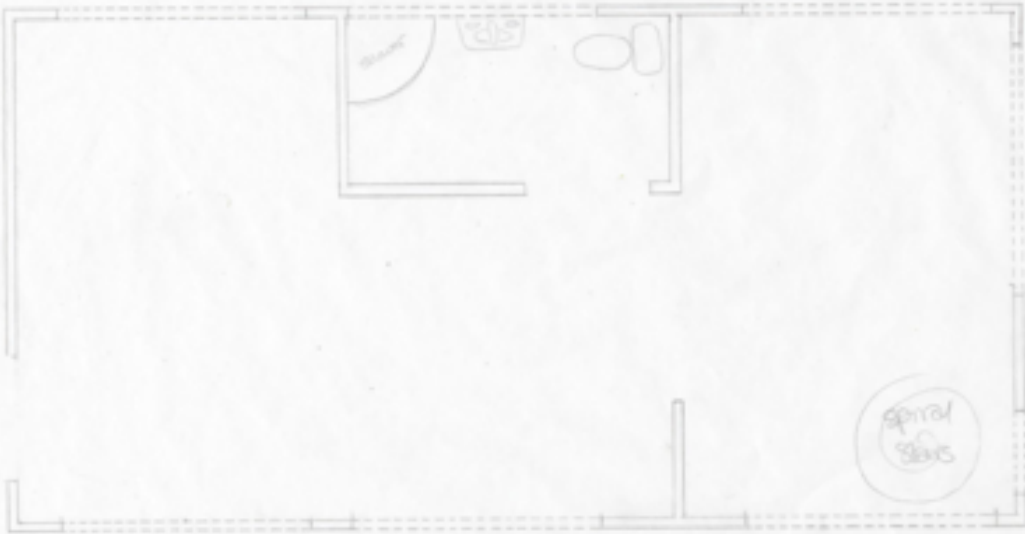

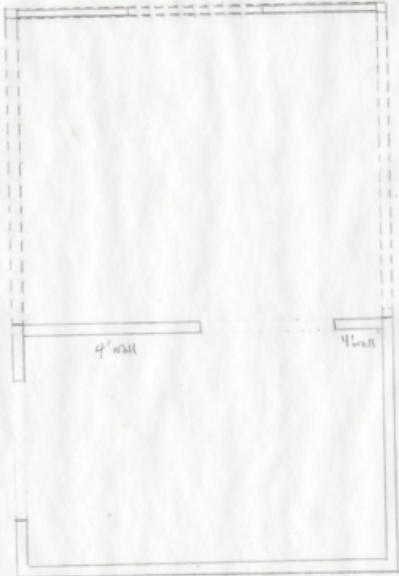

Floor Plan: 1st Floor



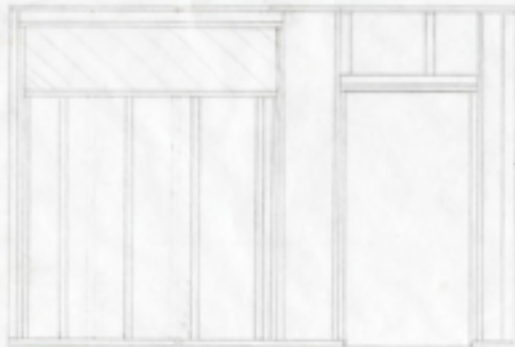
Floor Plan: 2nd Floor

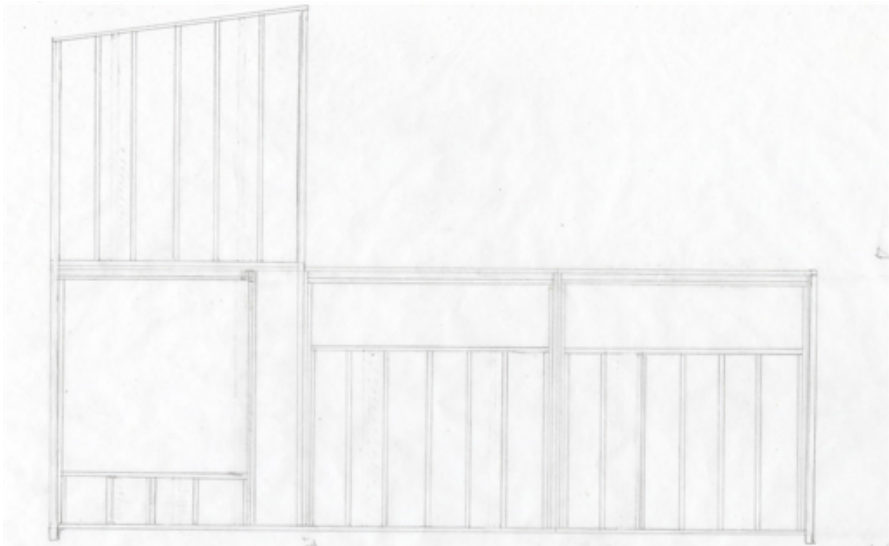

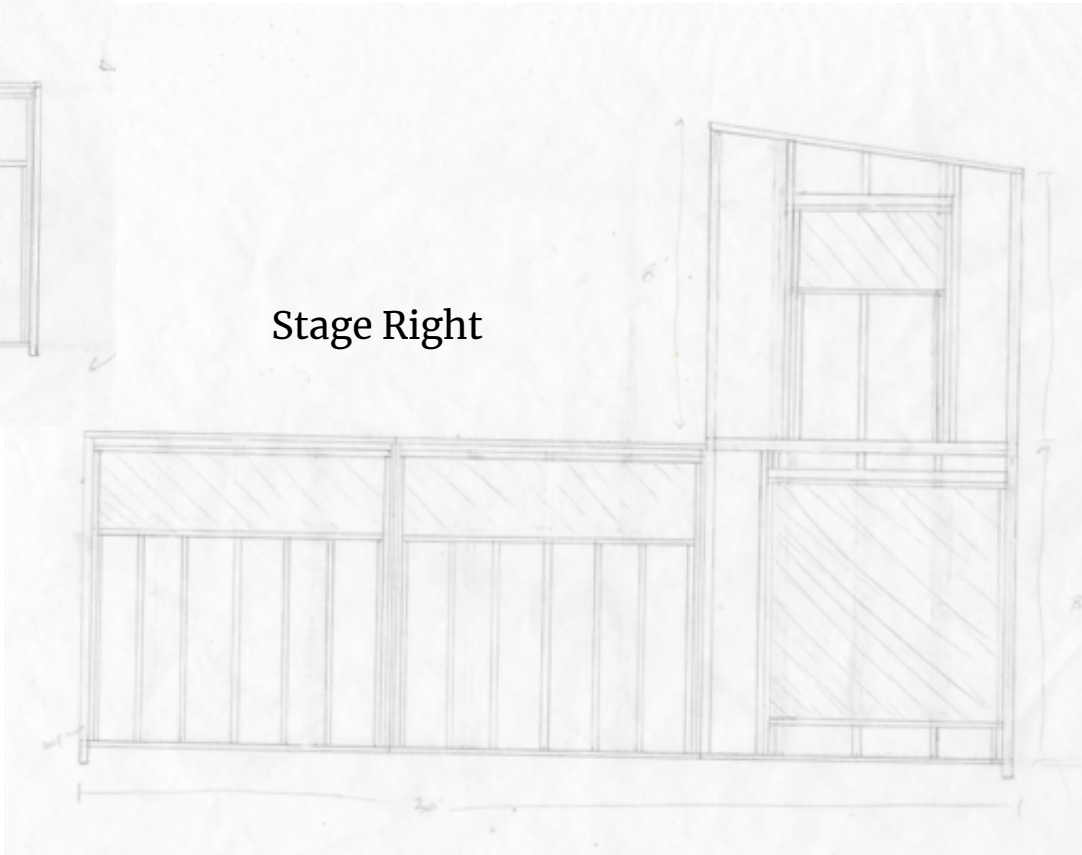
