Photo Contest Instructions:

Using the GoogleSlides doc Bio342_PhotoContest on our Google drive, create a slide including:

- 1. A photo that you took of a non-domestic non-zoo animal engaged in a behavior.**
- 2. A 2-3 sentence description of the behavior, using your most rigorous scientific interpretation to include its function (adaptive value), evolution, ontogeny, or underlying mechanisms the better. (not necessary to include citations) If this behavior is a mystery to you, item #3 should be more detailed.**
- 3. A brief but accurate and detailed descriptions of when and where this photo was taken. This may include description of context and surroundings. This is akin to what a field biologist may include in their field notes.**

Every student must complete at least one photo entry of a non-zoo, non-domestic animal. Additional entries are welcome.

Photos will be judged by students in Bio342 and Reed community members during the last couple weeks of the semester. There will be a category for best photography as well as a category for best scientific entry.

If you do not have a camera or phone camera, the stockroom has some point and shoots you can check out or the AV department has some nicer cameras that can be checked out.
