- Near Miss, Isopropanol and welding do not mix
  - One group was making mycelium pots and using IPA to sterilize but they moved to a location that people were welding
- New NMR purged again when filling

  - September event: Gasket went out and all the helium went out of the container.
     End of lifetime of a 20 year instrument.
  - This event with a new instrument: while filling by the instrument installer the helium tank it purged again. They left the door open and used a meter to make sure air quality was okay.
