

## **Czech Republic: New York University in Prague**

The NYU program in Prague enables Reed students an opportunity to study for a semester or year in the gorgeous capital city of the Czech Republic. Coursework, taught in English, focuses on the political and economic interests of new EU member states and the growing territorial and security interests of the Russian Federation. Areas of study include anthropology; art; literature; German Language; Hebrew and Judaic studies; Russian language and Slavic studies; film, photography, journalism and media studies; and music.
