

England: Oxford Center for Medieval and Renaissance Studies

The Center for Medieval and Renaissance Studies was founded in 1975 by Drs. John and Sandy Fenely: first, to establish a permanent institute for interdisciplinary study of the medieval, Renaissance, and early modern periods; second, to provide academic training for overseas students from all disciplines wishing to complete part of their education at Oxford but who are not matriculated members of Oxford University.
