

## Morocco: Regional Area Study with Lewis and Clark College

This program, delivered in collaboration with Lewis and Clark College, focuses on the history, culture, and social dynamics of Morocco and is held spring semester in Marrakesh, Agadir, and Fez. Students will have a host family experience, and can take courses that include intensive Arabic language, gender and society in Morocco, development and sustainability in Morocco, and Moroccan modernity.

<b>Qualifications:</b>	Open to sophomores and juniors who have completed first-year Arabic language or the equivalent.
<b>Term duration:</b>	Spring semester
<b>Typical course load:</b>	16 credits/semester (4.0 units)
<b>Courses recorded in:</b>	Semester hours
<b>Translates to Reed units:</b>	4:1 conversion of semester hours to Reed units (courses are typically 4 credits/one Reed unit)
