

USA: Wood's Hole Sea Semester

At the Sea Education Association (SEA), founded in 1971 at the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institute and affiliated with Boston University, undergraduates may study the ocean from a multitude of academic perspectives. Coursework focuses on maritime studies, nautical science, and oceanography and includes six weeks of applied studies aboard a sailing vessel.
