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## MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

### A. COMPARATIVE RACE AND ETHNICITY STUDIES (CRES) COMMON CORE REQUIREMENTS

Disciplinary CRES courses: One pair from each group (I and II) outside the home department:

#### I. Disciplinary Group I:

- a. Two Dance units, including at least one CRES Dance unit
- b. Two Literature units, including at least one CRES Literature unit
- c. Two Music units, including at least one CRES Music unit
- d. Two Theatre units, including at least one CRES Theatre unit

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#### II. Disciplinary Group II:

- e. Anthropology 211, and one CRES Anthropology unit
- f. Two History units, including at least one CRES History unit
- g. Two Linguistics units, including at least one CRES Linguistics unit
- h. Two Religion units, including at least one CRES Religion unit
- i. Sociology 211 and one CRES Sociology unit

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### B. INTERDISCIPLINARY REQUIREMENT (CRES 300)

### C. HOME DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS

1. 6 units in Dance, including Dance 201, Dance 211, and one unit of junior seminar in Dance; these must include at least 2 CRES units, at least one of which is cross-listed as a CRES foundational course. Non-graded courses in dance technique (Dance 101) can be counted towards this requirement.
2. Must achieve 300-level technical proficiency in one dance form and 200-level technical proficiency in a second dance form.
3. One CRES foundational course

## DIVISIONAL REQUIREMENTS

### STRONGLY RECOMMENDED: COMPARATIVE STUDY

1. Proficiency in a foreign language.
2. At least one CRES foundational unit
3. One or more CRES courses with an explicit comparative/transnational element
4. Study abroad

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## CREDIT AND DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS

**Humanities:** HUM 110 or equivalent (3 units)

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You may use courses in your major department to satisfy any one distribution requirement other than Group X.

Group Requirements must be fulfilled by two units from the same subject.

**Group A** Literature, Philosophy, Religion, Arts

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**Group B** History, Social Sciences, Psychology

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**Group C** Natural Sciences

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**Group D** Mathematics, Computer Science, Logic, Foreign Language, or Linguistics

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**Group X** 2 units in any one department outside of the major department

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30 units of coursework, 15 of which must be taken at Reed

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6 quarters of Physical Education, 2 of which may come from Community Engagement programs

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6 units completed during senior year

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
