

How to request your Grade Point Average (GPA):

If you are a current student, you may ask your academic adviser for your GPA. The registrar's office will verify the GPA for former students upon receipt of a signed request using the [Information Verification Request](#) form.

How your GPA is calculated:

Your Reed College GPA is calculated by dividing the total amount of *grade points* earned by the total amount of *units* completed. Grade points are weighted by the unit value of the course. Your GPA may range from 0.0 to 4.0.

Grade	Grade points used to calculate GPA
A+	4.00
A	4.00
A-	3.70
B+	3.30
B	3.00
B-	2.70
C+	2.30
C	2.00
C-	1.70
D	1.00
F	0.00

Classes taken Cr/NCr (Credit/No Credit), study abroad courses, and transfer courses are not factored in the student's Reed GPA. IN (Incompletes) and W (Withdrawals) do not receive grade points and are not calculated in the GPA.

Example:

Student Transcript			
Course	Units	Grade	Grade Points
BIOL 101	1	A	4
HUM 110	1.5	B	4.5
MATH 111	1	C	2
PSY 121	1	CR	0
4.5 Units Attempted			10.5 Total Grade Points
3.5 GPA Units Attempted			

To get the example student's GPA, divide the total grade points by the total number of graded units completed.

Total Grade Points	10.5		
Total GPA Units	3.5	$10.5 / 3.5$	$= 3.0$

To calculate your cumulative GPA, total the GPA units and then the grade points from all semesters. Divide the total grade points by the total GPA units. Please contact the registrar's office if you have questions: registrar@reed.edu
