

# ART HISTORY

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## MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

Applicants planning to major in art are not normally considered before successful completion, or reasonable certainty thereof, of Art 161 and 201. Transfers from other colleges, for whom in some cases one of these introductory courses may be waived, are expected to take a comparable amount of coursework at Reed before they can be considered as majors.

### A. REQUIREMENTS:

- Six and one-half units of art history, including Art 201, Art 301 (or approved equivalent), at least one course in non-Western art, and one course at the 400-level  \_\_\_\_\_  
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- Four units of studio art, including two 100 level art courses in different disciplines  \_\_\_\_\_  
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- Humanities 220, or two units from Humanities 211, 212, 231, and 232  \_\_\_\_\_  
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### B. JUNIOR QUALIFYING EXAM (ART HISTORY)

Normally, before taking the junior qualifying exam, students should have taken three units of art history at Reed (in addition to two 100-level art courses in different disciplines and Art 201).

## DIVISIONAL REQUIREMENTS

### EACH MAJOR IS EXPECTED TO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- Approval of all independent study (481) courses by the division

## CREDIT AND DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS

- Humanities:** HUM 110 or equivalent (3 units)  \_\_\_\_\_
- Distribution requirements must be fulfilled with 3 units in each of the following groups. 2 Units must come from the same subject and the third unit must come from a different subject.
- Group 1** Art, ANME (language and literature), Comparative Literature, CRES, Creative Writing, Dance, Languages, Literature, Music, Philosophy, Theatre  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_
- Group 2** Anthropology, ANME (archaeology and history), CRES, Economics, ICPS, History, Linguistics, Political Science, Religion, Sociology  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_
- Group 3** Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics, Psychology. *A substantial portion of at least one unit must be devoted to primary data collection and analysis.*  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_

**Notes:** No course can count towards more than one group. 200-level Humanities courses not used for the Humanities requirement can apply to either Group 1 or Group 2, but not both. A maximum of 2 units can come from language courses. If 2 units are being taken in language courses, the 2 units must be in the same language.

- 30 units of coursework, 15 of which must be taken at Reed \_\_\_\_\_/30
- 6 quarters of Physical Education, 2 of which may come from Community Engagement programs \_\_\_\_\_/6
