



## MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

### A. COMPARATIVE RACE AND ETHNICITY STUDIES (CRES) COMMON CORE REQUIREMENTS

## CREDIT AND DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS

- Group 3** Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics, Psychology.  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_  
*A substantial portion of at least one unit must be devoted to primary data collection and analysis.*

**Notes:** No course can count towards more than one group. 200-level Humanities courses not used for the Humanities requirement can apply to either Group 1 or Group 2, but not both. A maximum of 2 units can come from language courses. If 2 units are being taken in language courses, the 2 units must be in the same language.
