## DIVISIONAL REQUIREMENTS

## CREDIT AND DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENTS

Distribution requirements must be fulfilled with 3 units in each of the following groups. 2 Units must come from the same subject and the third unit must come from a different subject.

**Group 3** Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics, Psychology. *A substantial portion of at least one unit must be devoted to primary data collection and analysis.*  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_  \_\_\_\_\_

**Notes:** No course can count towards more than one group. 200-level Humanities courses not used for the Humanities requirement can apply to either Group 1 or Group 2, but not both. A maximum of 2 units can come from language courses. If 2 units are being taken in language courses, the 2 units must be in the same language.
