The center and this bin accept almost anything that Portland recycling and compost does not accept.

Includes and examples: [Items MUST be clean and dry.]

- Plastic bags/film stretchy, poke-able plastics (food storage bags, bubble/air wrap, case overwrap, six-pack rings, cereal bags)
- #1-7 Rigid Plastics any size, any number: scraps, lids, caps, clamshell containers, silverware, plastics labeled compostable
- #6: Polystyrene & **Styrofoam** many Solo™cups, coffee cup lids; foam cups, plates, & clamshells; block foam packaging
- Fabric&Shoes unpaired, ripped, stained, used; stuffed animals, belts, purses, towels, linens
- Ink Cartridges & **Electronic Waste** Can also bring to ETC.

- **Energy/Granola Bar** Wrappers
- Snack, chip, candy bag wrappers
- **Contact Lenses + Blister Packaging**
- **Personal Care&Beauty Packaging** Hair care packaging, makeup containers/tubes/ sticks/pencils
- Dental&Hygiene **Packaging** deodorant containers, soap packaging, floss containers, toothbrushes, toothpaste tubes
- **Writing Utensils** pens, dry-erase, crayons, pencils, felt tip, etc.

- Plastic wine corks & **Small craft supplies** paint brushes, stickers, magnets, tins, buttons, zippers
- **Wine Corks**
- **Bread Tags**
- **Office Supplies**
- **Free/Kommie Things** Usable items for others
- **EVERYTHING ELSE** and MORE accepted at the center
- Bring Hazardous Waste to Chem 211 instead of this bin. gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, paints, batteries, bulbs
