

Sexual Misconduct Climate Survey Summary Report

Fall, 2025

Executive Summary

Sexual and gender-based harassment, discrimination, sexual assault, relationship violence, stalking, and other forms of gender-based harm—collectively referred to as **sexual misconduct**—can negatively affect the well-being and academic success of students. Because most experiences of sexual misconduct are never formally reported, anonymous climate surveys are considered a best-practice for understanding the prevalence and impact of these behaviors on college campuses and for improving prevention and response efforts.

In 2023, Oregon passed legislation (HB 3456, now codified in ORS 350.335–346) requiring all colleges and universities in the state to administer a standardized sexual misconduct climate survey every two years. The Sexual Misconduct Survey Council, supported by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC), developed the base survey instrument and guidance for implementation. The purpose of the survey is to provide consistent, comparable information about the experiences, perceptions, and needs of students across Oregon’s higher education institutions.

Reed College administered the state’s prepared survey instrument in **December 2025**. The results are intended to inform campus education, prevention, and response efforts and to support an environment in which students feel safe, supported, and ready to seek help if they or someone they know experiences sexual misconduct.

For all questions in this section: if fewer than 5 students selected a response, show “<5” for *n* and display “NR” (not reported) for the percentage.

For all questions responses that are blank in the table, no responses were received for that option.

Summary Highlights -Section 2A. Sexual, gender-based, or sexual orientation harassment; sexual exploitation

- 40% of respondents experienced at least one of the listed behaviors related to sexual orientation harassment
- 1 in 4 students report gender-based or sexual-orientation harassment, and many say it happened multiple times.

Summary Highlights - Section 2B Stalking (stranger, acquaintance, or intimate partner)

- About 1 in 5 students (19%) report someone trying to communicate with them in a way that made them feel upset, uneasy, unsafe, alarmed, or fearful.
- About 1 in 14 students (7%) report being monitored, followed, watched, or tracked (including via technology).
- 65% say none of the listed stalking behaviors happened

Summary Highlights - Section 2C. Intimate partner violence

- 7% of students report that someone they were in a relationship with said things intended to embarrass, shame, or hurt them emotionally. 11% of all respondents experienced incidents related to this two or more times

Summary Highlights -Section 2D. Sexual violence

- 6% report being kissed or hugged in a sexual way without permission
- 7% report touching or grabbing of sexual body parts without permission
- 78% report none of these
 - Of those reporting unwanted sexual contact, 4% report it happened one time and 5% report it happened two or more times
- 1 in 8 students (approx. 12%) report some form of sexual coercion that resulted in sex since enrolling
 - Of those reporting sexual coercion, 5% report one time, 3% report two or more times

Summary Highlights - Section 3. Disclosure, reporting, & campus response

- About 3 in 10 students reported some experience of sexual misconduct
- 17% (n=36) of the full sample told someone about what happened (\approx two-thirds of those with experiences and follow-up).
- 6% (n=12) did not tell anyone.
- Students primarily confide in peers and close relationships, not institutions
- Students who disclosed to school employees sometimes received information on rights and options
- Fewer than 5 students said “Yes” to making a formal report-

Summary Highlights - Section 4. Effects and impacts of sexual misconduct

- 11% stopped social/extracurricular activities (friends, study groups, clubs, events).
- 10% had trouble focusing, paying attention, or remembering course material.
- 6% missed classes/assignments in ways that harmed their grades.
- 15% said they didn’t experience any of the listed academic/social impacts, while 9% said their social life or academics were affected in other ways not captured by the response options.
- Most students do not report major financial fallout connected to sexual misconduct
- 14% reported anxiety, depression, PTSD or post-traumatic stress.
- 14% reported isolation (avoiding social situations, ending relationships, not wanting to leave home/room).
- 11% reported emotional dysregulation (outbursts, mood swings, shutting down, difficulty controlling impulses)
- 9% disturbed sleep.
- 9% issues with memory, attention, focus, spacing out, or dissociation.
- 7% increased alcohol or drug use.
- 4–5% reported disordered eating, self-harming behaviors, or suicidal thoughts/attempts.

Summary Highlights - Section 5. Campus attitudes, safety, and awareness

- Most students say they know where to go to get help (80%) and understand how the institution defines sexual misconduct (79%).
- 57% (16% strongly agree, 41% agree) say they know what the institution will do when someone reports sexual misconduct.
- 89% (34% strongly, 55% agree) say they feel safe at this school. Students indicated their feelings regarding safety related to the following areas as well:

- o Sexual harassment: 78% agree/strongly; 6% disagree, 13% neutral.
 - o Relationship abuse: 65% agree/strongly; 7% strongly disagree; 19% neutral.
 - o Sexual violence: 76% agree/strongly; 4% disagree; 16% neutral.
 - o Stalking: 66% agree/strongly, 20% disagree and 10% are neutral.
- Only 41% (7% strongly, 34% agree) say the school does a good job of protecting students from sexual misconduct. (16% disagree/strongly disagree, and another 31% are neutral; 12% are unsure.)
 - 68% (17% strongly, 51% agree) say campus staff provide training to prevent sexual misconduct.
 - 73% (32% strongly, 41% agree) say most people at the school don't tolerate sexual misconduct.
 - 47% of students disagreed or strongly disagreed that sexual misconduct is not a problem at the school, while 41% reported neutral or unsure responses and 10% agreed.
 - 94% (44% strongly, 50% agree) believe people here would be supportive of a friend disclosing sexual misconduct.
 - 92% say they would try to stop friends making unwanted sexual jokes/comments.
 - 98% would talk to a friend they suspected was being hurt by a partner.
 - 89% would talk to a friend they saw harming a partner.
 - 70% would try to stop a stranger publicly harassing or hurting someone (29% strongly agree, 41% agree; 18% neutral).
 - 92% would try to stop someone who was trying to get another person drunk/high to have sex with them.

In this report, the phrase “*reported experiencing*” represents the responses made by students in this survey about their experiences of sexual misconduct.

When referring to formal reports made to the college (such as to Title IX or campus officials), we use the phrase “*made a formal report to the institution.*”

Our sincere gratitude goes out to all the students who took the time to share their experiences regarding sexual misconduct on campus by responding to this survey. We acknowledge the sensitive nature of the questions asked, and appreciate all responses provided. . This information plays a critical role in understanding the climate on campus regarding sexual misconduct. The college has a responsibility to assess our campus context, and take meaningful steps towards prevention. This report ensures the College can be responsive to the needs of our community. The offices of Title IX, SHARE, and Institutional Research, along with the Director of Assessment & Strategic Initiatives for Student Life will find meaningful ways to share these results and dialogue further with the community in the coming months.

- Survey solicitation, recruitment, and dissemination:
 - Announcements were made at a Student Senate meeting, in a “Campus News” email that went out to the whole community, in an email to students requesting participating, in an email to staff and faculty requesting they encourage student participation, and published in the student new paper.
 - Staff and students promoted the survey by tabling for two days from 11:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. and talking to passers by. At the table, a Zine publication with information about the survey, including how data would be collected and used, was handed out. Candy was made available to draw students to the tables.
 - Posters were hung around campus saying that the survey was coming.
 - Posters were hung around campus once the survey was opened with a QR code that would take students directly to the survey.
 - An email was sent to all students asking them to complete the survey and linking them to the survey once it was published.
 - An informational webpage was created and linked to in all electronic communications about the survey discussed above.
 - Incentive: College offered students who completed the survey the opportunity to be entered into a raffle. Prizes consisted of four College branded water bottles, four College branded totebags, and four \$25 College bookstore giftcards. (To enter the raffle, students were offered a link to a separate webpage where they could enter their student ID number. Raffle entries were not tied to survey submissions in any way.)
 - While the survey was open, two on campus opportunities were offered for students to drop in at the student center and use a College laptop to complete the survey. Tea, cookies, snacks, fidgets, student workers and professional staff were available in the space for support as needed.
- Opening and closing dates of the survey collection period: November 22 - December 22, 2026
